



HOUSE RULES

1. No Smoking in the house. Smoking is allowed in the designated areas only. (Back Patio or Front Sidewalk)
2. No Drugs or Alcohol allowed. No exceptions. Any resident in possession or suspected of being under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol will be subject to the termination of the contract
3. No gambling
4. No loaning and/or borrowing money from other residents.
5. Personal living area must be clean and tidy at all times. Beds must be made daily
6. No excessive clutter in rooms. The garage is to be used for storage
7. No eating in any areas of the house except the dining area
8. Monday-Thursday 11:00 PM Curfew. Friday through Sunday curfew is 12:00 AM. Weekend and overnight visits are permitted with prior authorization.
9. No overnight guests
10. All visitors must sign in
11. All visits are to be conducted in the community area of the house, such as the living/dining rooms, back patio
12. All residents will participate in family-style dining
13. Every resident is responsible for cleaning up after themselves
14. Each resident will be assigned a laundry day and will not be able to wash outside of their assigned day, unless the day is unassigned
15. There is "Zero tolerance" for verbal, physical violence/aggression, and/or threats of harm and intimidation of others. This will lead to automatic termination of the contract. No exceptions
16. All residents are expected to maintain proper hygiene and grooming
17. The individual assigned a room and bathroom must be cleaned daily by residents
18. Residents must wash and clean bed linen weekly
19. All residents will be given chores as assigned by the House Manager.
20. No Sexual activity
21. No Harassment (sexual, bullying) will be tolerated at any time
22. All residents must attend scheduled monthly house meetings
23. The House Manager can address any problems, complaints, and/or issues
24. Facility phone usage is limited to 15 minutes per call
25. Residents are expected to answer any "call waiting" on facility phones
26. All residents are independent and must be able to perform all activities of daily living consistently
